

PRE-OPERATIVE REQUIREMENTS

Rabies Vaccination Requirement

Your pet must have a current rabies vaccination prior to surgery, please bring your rabies certificate on the date of surgery for confirmation. If no rabies vaccination has been issued prior, we will administer one for a fee.

Age & Weight Restrictions/Requirements

Dogs & Cats over 4 months and up to 7 years of age will be eligible surgery, if your pet is outside of this range, we will be unable to perform surgery.



Cats must weigh a minimum of 3 lbs (pounds) to be eligible for surgery.

Dogs must weigh a minimum of 4 lbs (pounds) to be eligible for surgery.

Dogs or Cats that are considered overweight/obese or underweight/malnourished may not be eligible for surgery



Food & Drink

All pets five (5) months or older should not eat or drink from 8PM, the night prior to the surgery appointment.

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Consent & Waiver

All pet owners must complete a spay/neuter surgery consent and waiver prior to their pet undergoing surgery. Forms may be completed prior to or on the day of surgery.



Tests/Vaccinations Restrictions/Requirements

Some services may require tests prior to administering vaccines or medications to your pet. The Veterinarian on site will advise on these matters.



Prescription Medication

Only a licensed Veterinarian may consult with a pet owner regarding prescription medication(s) and advise on dosage, functions etc.

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
